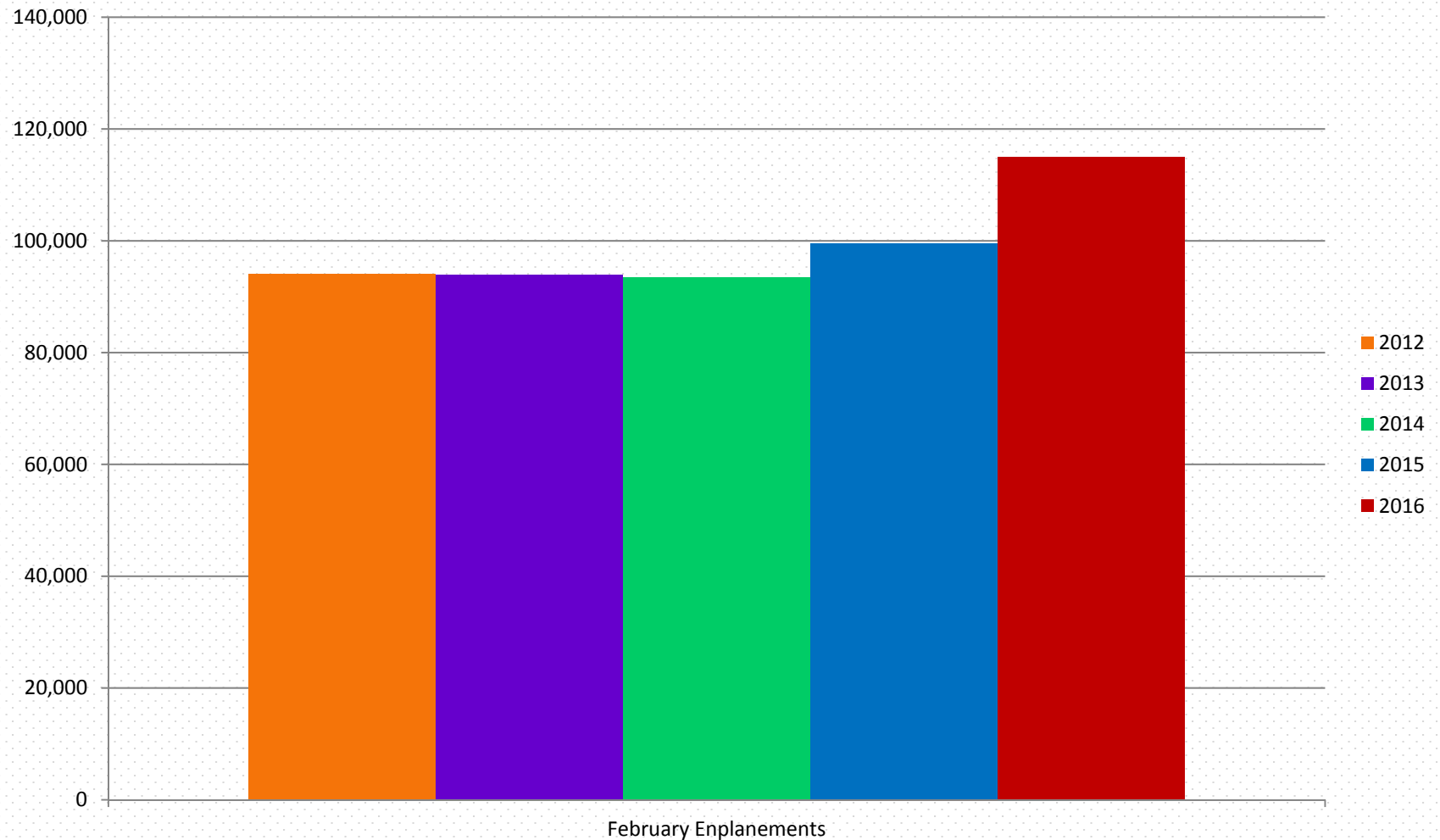

Proposed Syringa Valley Development

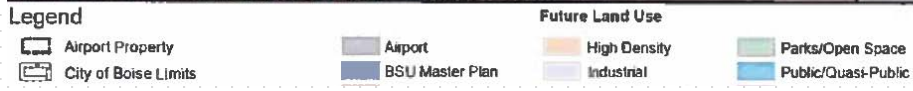
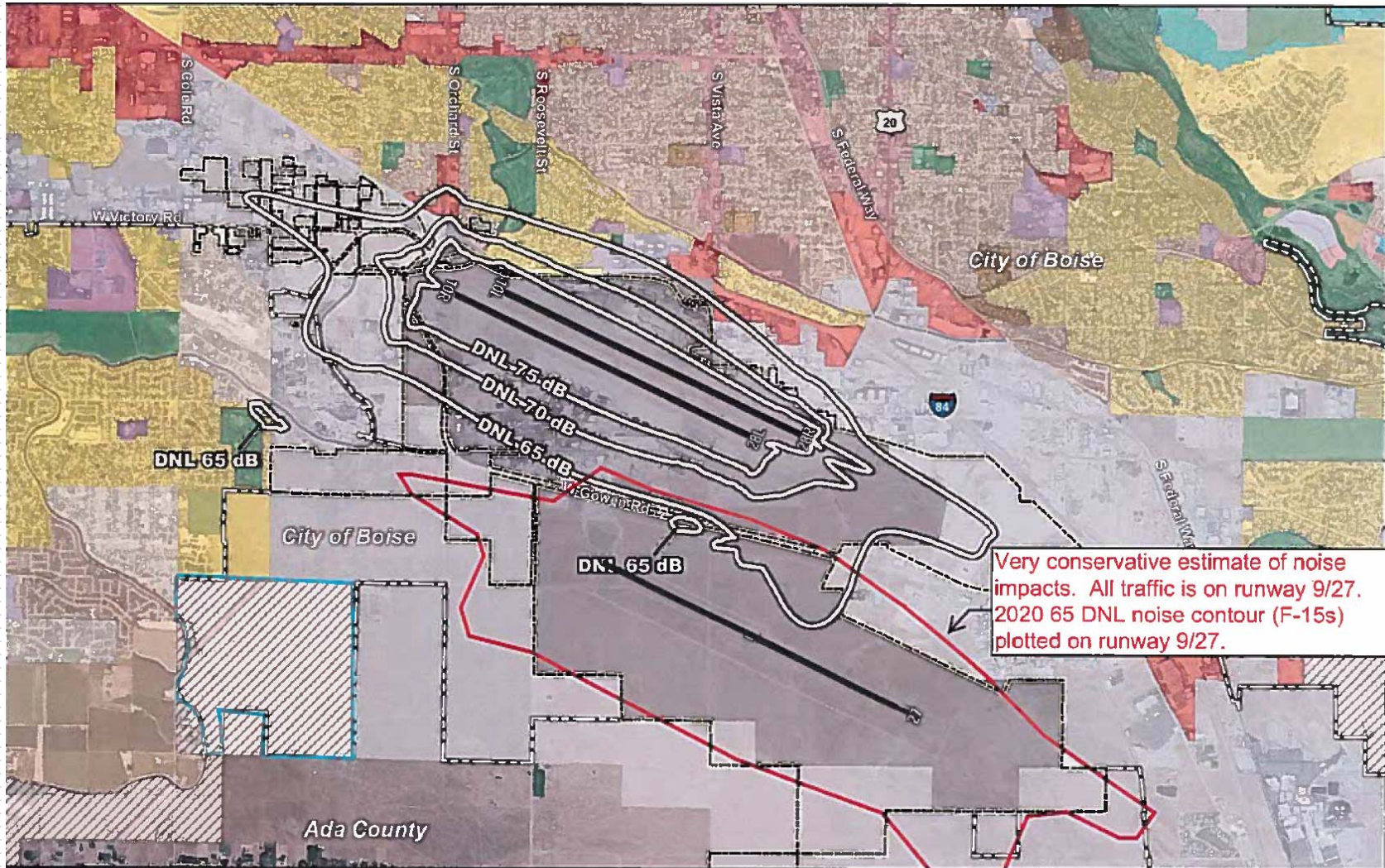
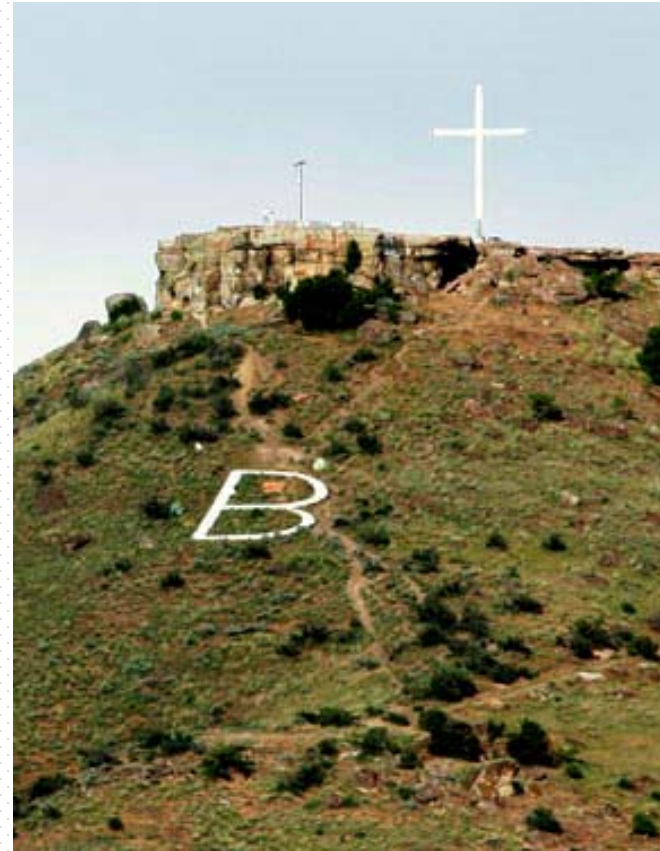
