Operations Update

- Feb 1 – Ops trip to FAA NWM Headquarters. The FAA approved updated ACM and AEP
- Feb 2 – Ops hosted a mid-season SMGCS Working Group, continuing work towards reducing minimums to 300RVR
- The Boise Airport and Boise Tower created an initial procedure for flying UAS within 5 miles of BOI. Information on iflyboise.com

Rotunda Restoration

- Demolition of existing terrazzo is complete.
- Eleven Relative Humidity probes have been installed
- First set of test results have been recorded
 - Results are between 95 to 100 percent
- Continue testing until results are below 70 percent

Airport Master Plan

- Ricondo & Associates Inc. were awarded the contract
- Sub Consultants
 - Mead and Hunt, Inc.

 - Quantum Spatial, Inc.

- 18 month process
- Typical Cost: \$900,000 - \$1,300,000
- Funded with Entitlement Grants

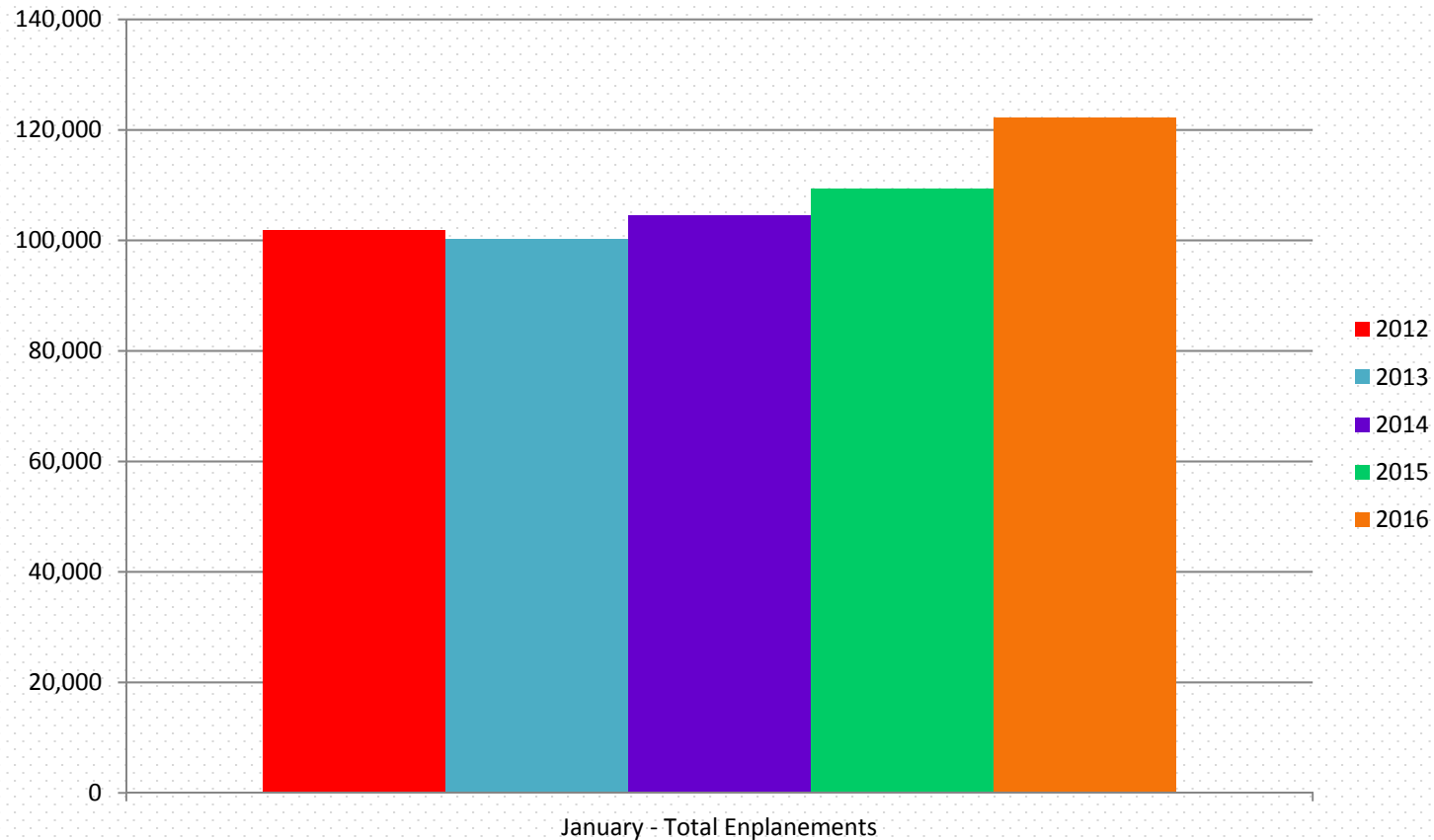
