Operations Update

- December 8-11: Annual FAA FAR 139 certification inspection and SMGCS certification inspection.
- December 27: Emergency landing, a Learjet reported nose gear issues, landed without incident.
- Multiple airfield snow removal and deicing events, no impacts to airport operations.



New Air Service

- Southwest Airlines began service to Sacramento on Wednesday, January 6.
- The new service will fly once daily, Monday – Friday.
- Southwest Airlines and Alaska Airlines now serve Sacramento.

- Live Christmas music during the holidays which included carolers, instrumental, and local musicians sponsored by 94.9 The River.

Part 150 Noise Study

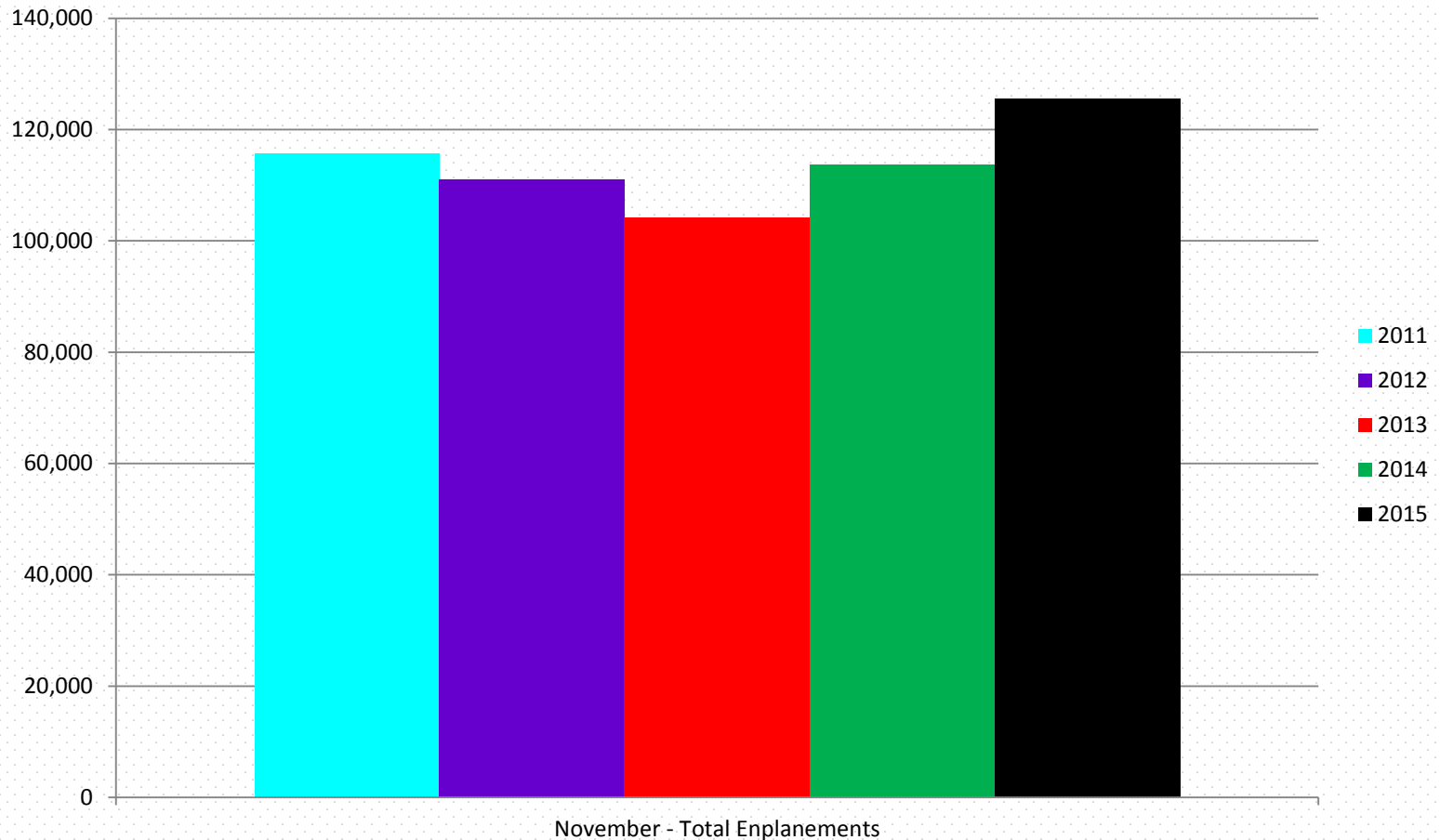
- Final public hearing was held on December 9th.
