# Part 150 Noise Study & Master Plan Update



- The Part 150 Noise Study was accepted, and comment period is over.
  - The FAA is currently reviewing the Noise Compatibility Plan.
  - The airport has responded to all individuals who have previously commented.
- The Master Plan contract has been awarded to Ricondo and Associates.
  - The project will take approximately 18 months to complete.
  - Stakeholders will be part of the process.



# Airfield Updates

- General aviation apron rehabilitation,
  - Scheduled completion by September 7, 2016.
- VALE Grant utilized for FedEx. Electric ground support equipment will reduce fossil fuel emissions.
- Passenger loading bridge extended at gate 21 to accommodate larger aircraft.

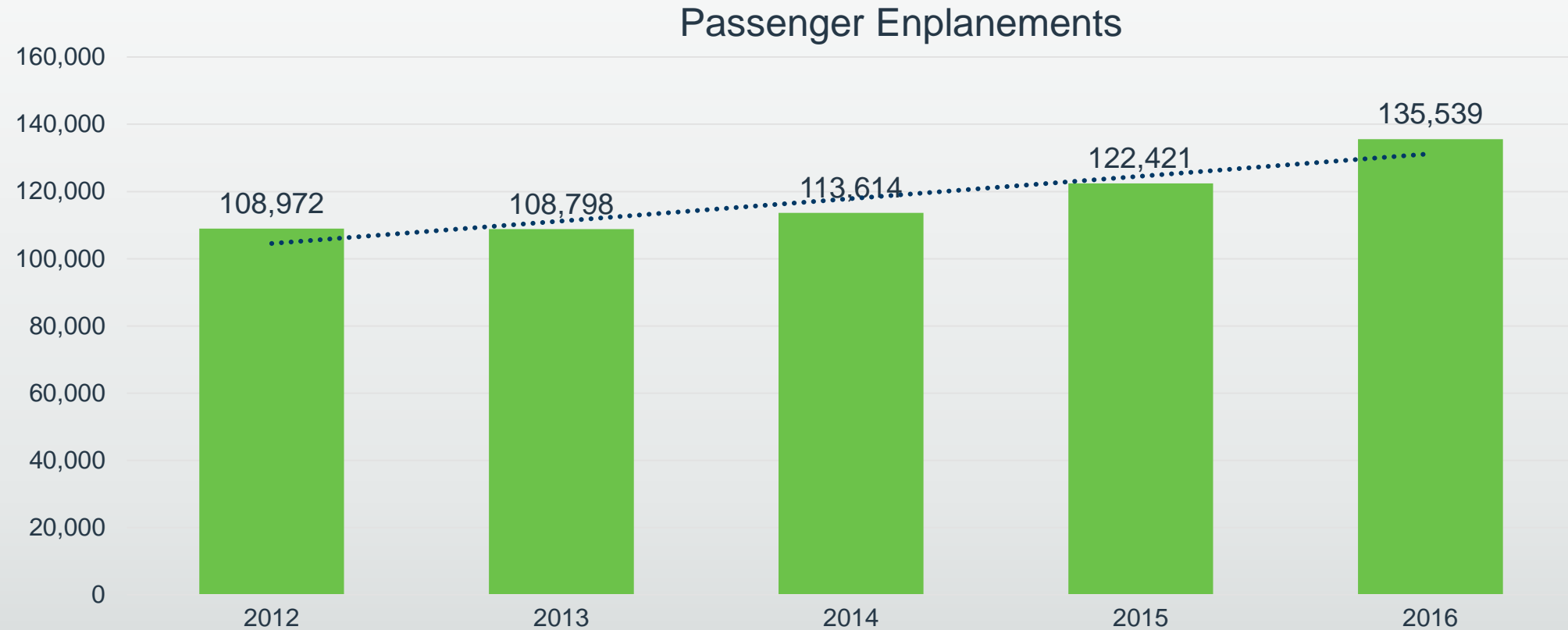

# May Enplanements

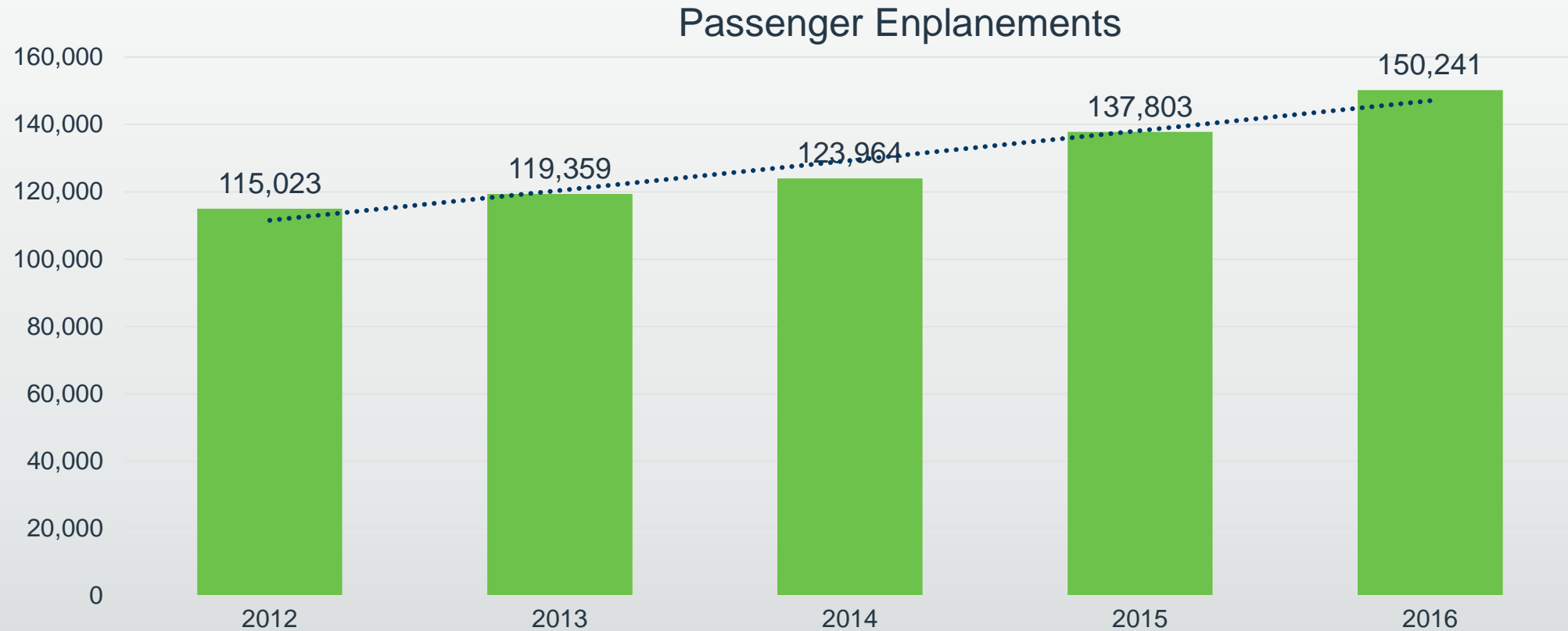
*Up 11% May 2016 over May 2015*
