April 4


Airport Ops hosted the Horseshoe Bend 5th Grade Adopt a Pilot Program for an airport tour

April Runway Closures


- April 5: 10R/28L, 8:00 A.M. 3:00 P.M. Closed for lighting preventative maintenance work

 Passengers appeared to enjoy the furry friends




March Enplanements
