Gowen Thunder Airfield Restrictions


- Only essential personnel are allowed in the aerobox
- Aerobox covers the majority of the airport operations area
- Restrictions are in place for safety, and required for show performance





Gowen Thunder Parking Locations

- 8 parking locations across the Treasure Valley
- Parking is first come, first serve
- Shuttles will run continuously throughout the day





F-35 Basing Announcement


- Announcement is expected to be made soon
- Boise will go through an Environmental Impact Assessment regardless of decision





Gate C11 Passenger Jet Bridge

- Passenger jet bridge installed
- Project is 90% complete
- Testing the jet bridge this week
- Expected to be in service on October 9





Taxiway A Rehab Update

- Phase 1 will be completed this Friday, October 6
- Phase 2 will repave Taxiway A, next to Taxiway M
- Expected to take 30 days





Masterplan Update

- Masterplan is approximately 60% complete

- There will be a farewell lunch on November 2







August Enplanements


Up 13% August 2017 over August 2016
