Two forms of ID are required. See the "List of Acceptable Documents" (page 7 of the application). Each identification must be from a different list, one of which must be a government issued photo ID. In addition, Non US citizens must present an Alien Registration Card or the I-94 Arrival/Departure Form. US citizens who were born abroad must provide either a US passport, Certificate of Naturalization or a Certification of Birth Abroad (DS-1350).

All fees, deposits, etc. must be paid to the Airport Accounting Office, located on the 3rd floor of the airport.
