

Gate C8-A, C Gate Signage


- Airport installed temporary digital signage at gate C8-A, where the new boarding bridge is located






December Enplanements

Down 52% December 2020 over December 2019




2020 Total Passengers

Down 52% over 2019




2020 Total Commercial Landings

Down 19% over 2019




2020 Total Freight On
