DBE GOAL METHODOLOGY

This overall goal period for the City of Boise, Boise Airport (the “Airport”) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (“DBE”) Program covers Federal Fiscal Years 2023 through 2025, a three-year period, beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2025. The Overall DBE Goal for the three-year period has been set at 4.3% in compliance with the methodologies described in CFR 49 Part 26 and subsequent guidance. FAA funding for AIP projects is anticipated to be approximately \$158.0 M over the three-year period. Note this goal was previously calculated at 4.4% but has been revised to add the Concourse B Family Restroom project which was not anticipate when the overall goals were previously submitted.

Geographic Region

The relevant geographic market for contractors for Boise Airport projects is defined as the Idaho Department of Transportation District 3 because more than 75% of the companies performing projects (including federally-funded contracts) at the Airport over the last three years are based in this area. The Idaho Department of Transportation District 3 includes the following counties: Ada, Adams, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, Owyhee, Payette, Valley, and Washington. The methodology for determining the DBE goal is described below.

STEP 1 - DETERMINE A BASE FIGURE REPRESENTING THE RELATIVE AVAILABILITY OF DBEs.

Based on the above, we recommend a base goal of 5.1% for Boise Airport projects for the three-year period.

STEP 2 - EXAMINE DATA TO DETERMINE WHAT ADJUSTMENT, IF ANY, IS NEEDED TO THE BASE FIGURE.

1) In accordance with 49 CFR part 26, section 26.45(d)(1)(i) We have reviewed the past history of DBE participation for Boise Airport projects over the last 5 years to determine if an adjustment should be made based on the current capacity of DBEs to perform work in our contracting program, as measured by the volume of work performed in recent years. Based on our analysis, we have determined that an adjustment is warranted as follows:

The median DBE participation accomplishment for the three-year period is 3.5%. Adjusting the base goal by airport for past history results in the following:

$$5.1\% \text{ (base goal)} + 3.5\% \text{ (median goal accomplishment)} = 8.6\% \\ 8.6\% \div 2 = 4.3\%$$

Therefore, we propose the Overall Goals for FY 2023 – 2025 is 4.3%

We will continue to monitor the project plans during this time period and update the goals as necessary for changes in the planned projects or scopes.

Note: The Idaho DOT (IDT) completed a Disparity Study in 2017. A revised Disparity Study will be completed in June 2023. The IDT DBE Goal for FFY 2021 – 2023 was based on the 2017 study as adjusted and was set at 7.25%. Given the fact that the Airport includes some purchasing activity as well as a significant amount of building trades, we believe that the airport's 4.3% goal is reasonable.

Race-Neutral versus Race-Conscious Goal

Race-Neutral versus Race-Conscious Goal

In light of the fact that Boise Airport does not have sufficient evidence of discrimination, the FFY 2023-2025 goal is proposed as a race-neutral goal as Boise Airport has not conducted a Disparity Study. We will monitor the progress towards the meeting the goal on a monthly basis and determine if an adjustment is necessary.

The following race-neutral methods will be employed:

- a) Provide information on the Boise Airport organization, functions and its full range of contractual needs.
- b) Offer instructions and clarification on bid specifications, procurement policy, procedures, and general bidding requirements.

- c) Maintain a file of successful bid documents from past procurements and permit potential participants to review and evaluate such documents.
- d) Conduct debriefing sessions on awarded contracts as requested.
- e) Routinely issue projected procurement information.
- f) Provide instructions and clarification on job performance requirements.
- g) Provide information and assistance on certification procedures.
- h) Provide information on sub-contracting practices and bonding requirements.
- i) When arranging solicitations, endeavor to allow time for preparation of bids, quantities, specifications and delivery schedules so as to facilitate the participation of DBEs.
- k) Develop, finalize, and implement (subject to FAA approval) a Small Business Program to function as a race-neutral element of the Airport's DBE Program.

In addition, Boise Airport staff conducted a meeting on January 11, 2023 to consult with minority, women's and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the Airport's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs (the "Stakeholder Meeting"). Information regarding the Stakeholder Meeting was posted on the Airport Website as well as distributed to the attached list of individuals/firms. There were ten attendees at the Stakeholder Meeting. There were no questions other than a question regarding the applicability of the IDT Disparity Study to the Boise Airport. The 2017 IDT Disparity study resulted in a goal of 7.25%. There is a new study currently underway. We stated that we would review the study to determine its applicability as it relates to availability when completed. Note that this revision resulted in a change of 0.1% to the overall goal. The result has been published but given the insignificant change, another stakeholder meeting was not held.
