

Privacy Notice for Collection of Secure Flight Passenger Data

The Transportation Security Administration of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security requires us to collect information from you for purposes of watch list screening, under the authority of 49 U.S.C. §114, the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004. Providing this information is voluntary; however, if it is not provided, you may be subject to additional screening or denied transport or authorization to enter a sterile area. TSA may share information you provide with law enforcement or intelligence agencies or others under its published system of records notice. All names must be legible and verifiable for approval. Please ensure the name you provide matches your legal identification documents.

The Transportation Security Administration requires travelers aged 18 or older to present a REAL ID, compliant driver's license, state issued ID, or another acceptable form of identification (such as a valid U.S. passport), in order to board domestic commercial flights or access the Secure/Sterile/SIDA area.

A REAL ID compliant card can be identified by a star in the upper portion of the card. If your ID does not display this marking, it is not REAL ID compliant, and you must provide an alternate acceptable form of identification to avoid delays or denial of access.
